DIY Miniature Books

Flip Book

Trace around the matchbox to create a template. Cut out rectangles, just a smidgen smaller than the traced template. Stack one on top of the other. Staple.



Paper Clip Book

Cut out rectangles with above template technique. Use a small hole punch to punch a hole through the side, on the short ends. Thread a paper clip through the hole.



Miniature Scroll

Using your small rectangular pieces of paper, roll each up into a scroll. Tie with a twist



Accordion or ZIG-Zag Book

Trace around the matchbox on your paper. Extend the long lines into a strip and cut just inside of the lines. Fold the edge of the strip of paper to the traced line of the box. Continue folding under and over in a zig-zag fashion.

Step One: Fold paper into fourths, lengthwise and widthwise.




Step Two: Cut the paper to the third block on every level. Lines drawn

for better view.



Step Three: Fold paper like an accordion.



Step four: Tape the spine. Once done, you can either cut the pages that are still connected, or glue them together. (At this point you're basically done. But if you want to make your DIY a little more fancy, proceed to step five).
