The children have continued to enjoy our exciting enquiry curriculum this week. Year 2 were introduced to directional language and navigation. They had great fun using compasses on the playground and working out where North, South, East and West were. Year 1 children have been captivated by the antics of our chicks who had a little run around outside their classrooms in an improvised chicken run. The children observed, discussed wrote about and drew the chicks. The birds have now gone to a new home on a farm in Norfolk owned by one of our children's Grandad's. We have been promised pictures and updates so watch this space! Our reception children have shared "Not Now Bernard" as part of 'The drawing club' programme. 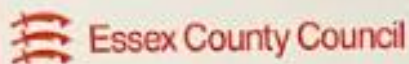

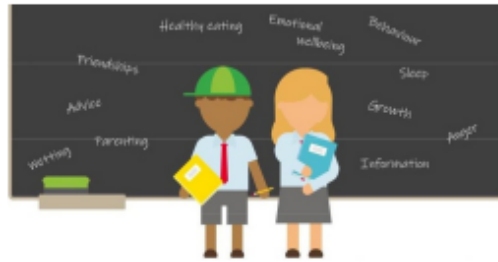
