



Vocabulary		Colour Mixing	Sticky Knowledge
pattern	A repeated design using lines, shapes or colours.		<input type="checkbox"/> Primary colours are red, yellow and blue. <input type="checkbox"/> Primary colours can be mixed to make secondary colours: <input type="checkbox"/> There are many different shades (or 'hues') of the same colour. <input type="checkbox"/> Changing the amount of the primary colours mixed affects the shade of the secondary colour produced.
hue	Describing an exact colour.		
colour mixing	Mixing colours to make a new colour.		
primary colours	Red, blue and yellow - these cannot be made from other colours.		
secondary colours	Purple, green, orange - these can be made by mixing two primary colours together.		
print	Transferring an image onto another surface.	Artists
