Sculpture	A piece of art that you can see from all sides because it is three-dimensional.	 	<input type="checkbox"/> Art is made in different ways. <input type="checkbox"/> Art is made by all different kinds of people. <input type="checkbox"/> An artist is someone who creates. <input type="checkbox"/> I can roll and fold paper. <input type="checkbox"/> I can cut and glue paper to make 3D structures. <input type="checkbox"/> I can make shapes in paper, e.g. spiral, zig-zag.
Cylinder:	A tube shape with two flat ends and a round body.		
3D Art:	Art that is not flat but has height, width, and depth.		
Paper Rolling	A technique where you roll paper to create shapes like tubes or cylinders.		
Concertina	A folding technique that looks like an accordion.	Artist - Samantha Stephenson	
Collaborate	Work together with someone else.	 	
Overlap:	When one piece of paper lies partly over another.
