- The Church prays the Creed and the Our Father to pray to God and worship him.



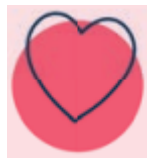
- God wants us to love and care for the world because the world is God's gift to us.

Skills I need to use:

- Recognise** that all comes from God, who made heaven and Earth.
- Recognise** that we can sense God from the beauty of Creation.
- Recognise** that humans must take care of our world, show love for God and each other.
- Recognise** that prayer draws us closer to God.



- Talk** about God's gift of Creation through art, music, poems.
- Talk** about why caring for God's world matters to them and the local community.



- Reflect** on what the words of the Our Father and the opening of the Creed say to them.
- Reflect** on different ways to pray
- Listen** to different ways of caring for the world.
- Talk** about how they can care for God's world.
