- Listen to the religious experiences of others from different communities in the class and the local area.

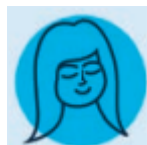
Skills I need to use:

Describe a way Christians work together locally and globally in the service of others.

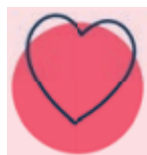
Make simple links and connections between some Jewish religious laws, beliefs, worship, and life
