Skills I need to use



- The Annunciation of John the Baptist (Lk 1:5-20) and Jesus (Lk 1:26-38)
- The Visitation (Lk 1:39-50, 53)
- The birth of John the Baptist (Lk 1:57-58)
- Zechariah's voice is restored (Lk 1:59-66, 67,76)
- The Birth of Jesus (Lk 2:1-8)
- Including, for the season of Advent: Is 7:14, 9:1-2, 5-7 (Extracts from the book of Immanuel)



- That prophets and prophetesses communicate God's message inspired by the Holy Spirit. John the Baptist is born to be a prophet.
- The person Isaiah spoke of was Jesus - 'God-with-us'.
- Advent is when Christians prepare for the coming of Jesus Christ at Christmas.
- Mary is the mother of God who is trusted with all our prayers.



- The Magnificat (Lk 1:46-50, 53)
- Advent is preparing for Jesus' coming.
- The Advent wreath is a symbol of the coming of the light.
- The Christmas story is celebrated in song: carol services.



- Catholics around the world show honour to Mary.
- Advent preparations for Christians and in different cultures.
- The meaning of the candles/wreath.
- Catholic Social Teaching (CST) can help to guide Christians to 'share the light' with others.

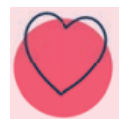


Retell accounts from the Annunciation and the birth of John the Baptist and of the Annunciation and the birth of Jesus

Know that a prophet or prophetess communicates God's message. Isaiah and John the Baptist are prophets. **Identify** Zechariah's special message about John's future. **Recognise** that the Church teaches that the person Isaiah spoke of was Jesus long before he was born.

Describe some ways that Christians prepare for Jesus' coming at Christmas during the season of Advent

Recognise the meaning given to the Advent wreath and how these might help Christians prepare for Christmas.



Talk about light and darkness

Say what I wonder about the Holy Spirit and how baby John the Baptist, Mary, Elizabeth, and Zechariah felt.

Talk about how other cultures and communities prepare in Advent.

Listen to different traditions and interpretations of the meaning of the Advent wreath.
