



Vocabulary Progression Nursery – Year 2

Rationale

Vocabulary is the gateway to learning. Research demonstrates that a rich vocabulary improves reading comprehension, writing, communication and academic success across the curriculum.

This progression document is based upon Beck, McKeown and Kucan's Three-Tier Model of Vocabulary:

EYFS

In the Early Years, the focus is on developing a strong foundation of Tier 1 vocabulary. Through high-quality interactions, stories, songs, role play and continuous provision, children are exposed to and encouraged to use everyday language relating to their immediate experiences, such as family, emotions, routines, play and the world around them.

For EAL learners, practitioners make language comprehensible through the use of visuals, gestures, modelling, repetition and real-life experiences. Home languages are valued and celebrated, helping children make connections between their existing knowledge and new English vocabulary.

Alongside Tier 1 vocabulary, children are gradually introduced to carefully selected Tier 2 words through high-quality texts and sustained shared thinking. These words are explicitly taught, revisited and embedded within different contexts.

Year 1 and Year 2

As pupils progress through Key Stage 1, there is an increasing emphasis on the explicit teaching of Tier 2 vocabulary. These high-utility words, such as *predict*, *compare*, *explain*, *discover* and *observe*, are taught across subjects to enable pupils to access classroom talk, texts and learning tasks.

Subject-specific Tier 3 vocabulary is also introduced systematically. In science, pupils learn words such as *habitat* and *materials*; in geography, *continent* and *human features*; and in mathematics, terms such as *partition*, *equal* and *digit*. Vocabulary is carefully planned, pre-taught where necessary and revisited frequently to support retention.

Vocabulary Across the Curriculum

Throughout Nursery to Year 2, vocabulary instruction is woven into all curriculum areas. Teachers identify key vocabulary for each unit of learning and provide multiple opportunities for pupils to hear, discuss, practise and apply new words.

Strategies used include:

- Explicit vocabulary instruction before, during and after learning.
- Visual supports, images and concrete resources.
- Repetition and retrieval opportunities.



- Sentence stems and structured talk.
- Partner discussions and oral rehearsal.
- High-quality storybooks and rich texts.
- Modelling of academic language by adults.
- Opportunities to use new vocabulary in meaningful contexts.

Vocabulary is deliberately planned so that pupils:

- Encounter words repeatedly.
- Use vocabulary orally before applying it independently.
- Revisit vocabulary across subjects and year groups.
- Develop increasing precision and sophistication in language.

Impact on EAL Learners

This tiered approach supports all learners as well as EAL learners by bridging the gap between social and academic language. It enables pupils to build vocabulary systematically, develop confidence in speaking and listening, access increasingly complex texts and participate fully in classroom learning.

By ensuring vocabulary is explicitly taught, repeatedly revisited and carefully sequenced from Nursery to Year 2, we help all pupils, regardless of their starting point in English, to develop the language needed to thrive across the curriculum.

Key:

- Tier 1 (Everyday vocabulary) – words children are likely to encounter in everyday conversation or already know through play and experience.
- Tier 2 (High-utility academic vocabulary) – words used across multiple subjects that help children describe, compare and explain.
- Tier 3 (Subject-specific vocabulary) – specialist art vocabulary linked directly to the curriculum content.
