School Crossing Patrol Service – Safety Message

Cyclists and Scooter Riders

Could pupils who bring bikes and scooters to school, please dismount, and walk their bikes and scooters over the crossing. This advice is relayed to all pupils in Essex who bring bikes and scooters to schools and cross with patrols. This will improve the safety for all St Anne Line pupils, pedestrians, and the patrol. This is also very good practise for when children get older and make unaccompanied journeys, as they will be used to dismounting and this will enable them to give their full attention to approaching traffic. Thank you.

Holding the Hands

There have been several incidents recently across Essex where young children have run into the road. Younger children do not see the dangers and their periphery vision is not fully developed; therefore they will often start to cross the road as soon as the patrol walks into the road. Please hold the hands of younger children as you approach the crossing site and relay that they should remain alongside you on the kerb until the patrol is in the middle of the road and has indicated to you that it is now safe to cross. Thank you.

Drivers parking in Great Knightleys

Would driver please stop parking illegally on the double yellow lines close to the school crossing site. The lines have been put there to improve safety for St Anne Line pupils. When vehicles park close to the crossing site, visibility of approaching traffic is reduced for the patrol and other vehicles then accelerate to overtake the parked vehicles. I have contacted the Enforcement Team with regards to this illegal parking and have requested that they monitor the area on a regular basis.

Drivers dropping off pupils close to the crossing site.

Drivers should not drop pupils off close to the crossing site as other vehicles could overtake your stationary vehicle before being aware of the patrol and other pedestrians in the road ahead. You are putting your own children at risk, when parents let their children out from vehicles and then wait to watch their child cross without realising that other vehicles are likely to overtake your stationary vehicle and both the patrol and the pupils are at risk of an accident. The patrol needs clear vision before he stops traffic and enters the road to ensure the safety of pupils and himself. Thank you.

Summer School Uniform

A reminder that summer school uniform can now be worn as follows (weather permitting):

- Nursery - Red shorts with an elasticated waist, red & white checked summer dress
- Reception - Grey school shorts with an elasticated waist, red & white checked summer dress
- Key Stage 1 - Grey school shorts, red & white checked summer dress

In the warmer weather children must have sun cream applied and have a sun hat (named) for outdoor learning/play times.
