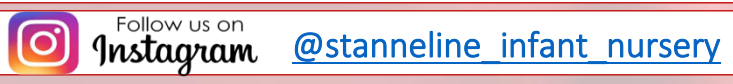

Also children should not wear jewellery, i.e., earrings on Thursdays and Fridays as we have Multiskills on those days.



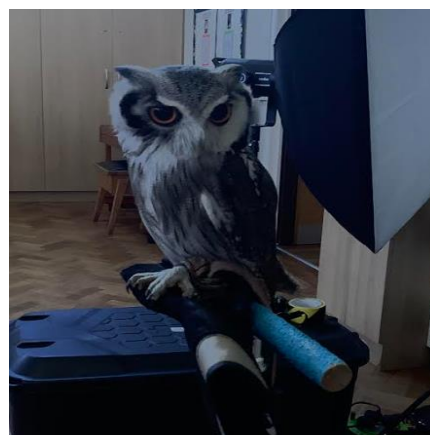
Reception Stay and Pray – Wednesday 12th June
