- Lent is a special time for praying, fasting, and helping others as Jesus taught us to do.
- Jesus died and rose again.



- Simple words, actions, and symbols from the Ash Wednesday liturgy and the Palm Sunday liturgy.
- Lent is a special time when Christians pray, give up things they do not need, and help people..
- Experience music or art that reflects how Christian communities around the world celebrate Lent and the last week of Jesus' life.



- Fasting is a way of giving things up to help others and for Catholics, CAFOD Family Fast Day is a way of doing this.
- Fasting, praying, and giving to others are ways of following Jesus' example.

Skills I need to use



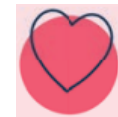
Make simple connections between Jesus' time in the desert and Christians praying and fasting for forty days.
Recognise that Jesus shows the importance of giving to others, making simple connections with the story of the widow's mite and the season of Lent.

Sequence the events of the last week of Jesus' life.

Recognise that angels bring God's message and are a sign that Jesus is the Son of God, truly alive.

Recognise that the Church teaches that Jesus suffered, died, and rose again.

Recognise simple connections between the use of ashes and the Christian belief that Lent is an opportunity for a new start.



Ask 'I wonder' questions about the story of the last week of Jesus' life.

Experience and reflect on music or art that shows Christians around the world celebrate Lent and the last week of Jesus' life.



Recognise that fasting in Lent is giving something up to help others and CAFOD Family Fast Day is a way of doing this.

Consider what they might give up and choose to do to help

others.

Reflect on what they know about Jesus including the events of the last week of Jesus' life and his resurrection.
