- Jesus is the 'light to all nations'.

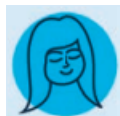


- The Feast of the Presentation of Jesus is celebrated by Christians around the world and is known as Candlemas in Britain.

Skills I need to use

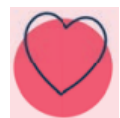


Identify some people that meet Jesus and recognise he is special.
