Kreate Dance Teacher £4275	Staff have developed their skills and knowledge of teaching dance. Children are able to copy, create and enjoy dance as a form of exercise and a healthy lifestyle approach.	Children will complete a term of dance PE lessons with their class teacher. At playtime and lunchtime the children have access to a "stage" area and a bluetooth speaker where they can continue to develop and practise their dance skills all year round.
PE curriculum scheme £360	Staff have an ambitious curriculum which is fully inclusive for all pupils through the delivery of iMoves.	Staff are trained and continuous videos and curriculum updates ensure that teachers are up to date with the most recent method and strategies.
PE Coach £6310	Children have access to a highly qualified PE Coach at least once per week and break times.	Teachers and other school staff are able to observe good PE practise to implement during their lessons or playtime support.
